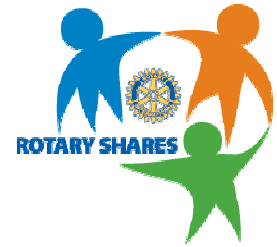

"Why in the world do you need cyanide?"

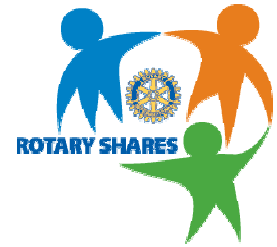
The lady replied,
